- Began the 18th year coaching baseball in the Eastwood Optimist program. (Worked 4 years in Little League Baseball in Snyder, Texas before coming to El Paso. Was Vice President of Little League 3 years).
- 2. Head commissioner of Eastwood Optimist baseball-softball 1983. There were total of 89 teams.
- Seven years assistant baseball-softball commissioner, Eastwood Optimist program.
- Seven years baseball-softball sponsorship chairman, Eastwood Optimist program.
- 5. Coached baseball teams which have been in championship playoffs 15 out of past 16 years.
- 6. Seventeen years coaching and commissioner of basketball:
 - A. 5 years as coach in Eastwood Optimist basketball program.
 - B. 12 years coaching in city church league basketball program.
 - C. Served as commissioner of basketball in the city church league, boys' division for 7 years.
- 7. Commissioner of the boys and mens city church league basketball in 1981-1982.
- 8. Commissioner of the TAAF state tournament for boys church league in 1982.
- 9. Won city league championship Gold medal tournament in 1974, boys 12-13 year old major division, after winning the Eastwood Optimist major division.
- Placed second in city church league in 1976 and third place gold medal tournament - high school age boys.
- 11. Won three boys city church league championships and represented El Paso in the state tournament in Dallas 4 years (1977-1981).

- 12. Commissioner of boys church league softball for four years.
- 13. Before Optimist program began, coached softball team for Immanuel Baptist Church boys team pre-season (for 4 years) until a head coach could be chosen.
- 14. One year after Optimist baseball season was over, the coach at IBC left the team. Therefore, I coached the softball team in the state church league tournament. We beat the top-seated team, Houston, in the first game. We came in only fourth in the tournament, which was won by Dallas.
- 15. Commissioner of football in Eastwood Optimist program in 1982 and 1984.
- 16. Assistant commissioner of football for 3 years in Eastwood Optimist program.
- 17. Coached football in Eastwood Optimist program for 3 years.
- 18. Presently working with the El Paso Parks and Recreation Sports Department to restructure the 1985 Eastwood Optimist football program. The age of eligibility will be lowered to 7 years in order to allow more youth to be involved in football. A "Little Bowl" will be held in the new age group.
- 19. Have served as Athletic Director at Immanuel Baptist Church for several years and am now chairman of the athletic committee.
- 20. Started a fourth, fifth and sixth grade church basketball league, open to other churches, and the league still continues after 7 years.
- 21. Each Saturday morning for the past 7 years, have served as referee for the fourth, fifth, and sixth grade church league basketball.
- 22. Started two seventh, eighth and ninth grade church basketball leagues for boys and girls. The boys league continues after 7 years.
- 23. Organized a womens' church league and had 6 churches involved in basketball. This league was discontinued.
- 24. Organized a mens' church league in basketball, separate from the city church league. Games were played at Immanuel and Scotsdale Baptist Churches. This league continues after 8 years.

- 25. Helped organize a church league mens' slow-pitch softball. This league continues after 6 years.
- 26. Organized a womens' fast-pitch softball church league. This league only lasted 3 years.
- 27. Was instrumental in getting a girls' softball league in the Eastwood Optimist program.
- 28. Was instrumental in getting girls' basketball started in the Eastwood Optimist program.
- 29. In 1984, coached boys' church league basketball. When the season was over, commenced coaching the mens' church league basketball.
- 30. Was external Vice-President in charge of all sports programs in the Eastwood Optimist program from 1979-1980. Was the only person to be the Head Commissioner and Head Coach at the same time.
- 31. Have served on board of directors in the Eastwood Optimist for past 8 years in one capacity or another to formulate and finalize sports programs for our club.
- 32. Was instrumental in restructuring the girls' and boys' softball-baseball and boys' softball-baseball programs. We separated ages as 7-8, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, and 15-16, called Pinto, Mustang, Bronco, Pony and Colt league, respectively. Also initiated the "must play two consecutive innings" rule for all ages except Colt league, which play in the city program.
- 33 Also, worked in Boy Scouts about 12-15 years as Cub Scout Master, Webelow Leader and committeeman.

Additionally, I have worked closely with the City Parks & Recreation Department for many years. I also still find time to see quite a few of the Diablo's baseball games, Miner football and basketball games, Eastwood High School boys and girls basketball and all of Eastwood High's football games.

During the baseball season, I spend about 30 hours a week working in and with the Eastwood Optimist baseball-softball program.
